Parking at Vic West

With the increase in the number of students attending Vic West this school year, we have seen an increase in the number of parents/caregivers dropping off and picking up their children every day. If you have ever driven your child to our school, you will know it can be a tight squeeze sometimes.

There are certain areas that are unsafe and illegal to park in. In order for the morning and afternoon flow of traffic to remain safe to all persons on our school grounds, it is important for drivers to be aware of where it is ok to park and drop off/pick up. **Please do not park behind the school by the gym.** It is very difficult to be seen in that area, and there is a major safety concern for our students and staff. In addition, **please do NOT park in the handicapped parking areas as these are needed by some of our community members.**

Front Street and the roads leading into the school can become quite congested during the morning drop-off and afternoon pick up times. **Please park on the side roads if you need to come into the school.** The driveway is for drop-off and pick up only, and the parking lot is reserved for staff. Because we have staff that come at different hours, an empty spot in the morning does not mean that it won't be needed later in the day. As always, we appreciate your assistance with this, and we understand that on some days it can be very trying to navigate.
