COMMUNITY CONSULTATION RE: EARLY LEARNING CENTRE AND CHILD CARE SPACES

For the Families of Vic West Elementary School -

Mark Walsh, GVSD Secretary-Treasurer and Marni Vistisen-Harwood, Manager of Capital Planning and Implementation, will be providing a community consultation regarding the Early Learning Centre and Child Care Spaces on Thursday February 28th at 6:30pm at Vic West Elementary.

This meeting will take place in the school library. All parents and guardians of Vic West Elementary are invited to attend.

Lunch Program - Changes

Our lunch program is changing to a NEEDS only program.

The lunch program will continue but with a different focus. We are moving to a NEEDS only program. Families who have used the program in the past because it is easier than making lunch at home are asked NOT to register under these new guidelines. To reduce the cost for those in need, we have eliminated the beverage as we have plenty of drinking water available from our new fountains.

CommunityLINK Programs will still help fund the School Meal Program, and continue to need your contributions. Your child's lunch costs the School District \$3.86 per day. Families in need of this program are asked to contribute their Fair Share that they can manage at the time.

Some suggested payment options might be:

- 1) Pay full cost for the first child and half for each additional child.
- 2) Pay \$25 dollars for the first child and \$10.00 for each additional child.
- 3) Whatever contribution your family can afford, no matter how small.

4) If you are unable to contribute this month, your child or children are still welcome to register for the program.

No child should go hungry at lunch and each family should support the program with whatever amount is possible


