Watch for immunization consent packages for students in kindergarten to grade 4 who are behind on their immunizations. Students will be offered immunizations at a public health office with the consent of a parent, guardian or representative. Parent(s), guardians or representatives will be required to accompany students to the public health immunization appointment.

Students who are up to date on their immunizations will receive a record of immunization. Please keep this record to provide to your child's school this fall.

First Nations children who receive health services in their communities may be able to access immunization records and services at their Community Health Centers.

For Parents/Guardians of Students Attending Vic West Elementary School in the 2019 2020 School Year:

Parents/Guardians, this is an invite to share educational information about your child that would help with the decision-making process for class building. If you are interested in sharing information, please submit a letter by May 15, 2019.

Such information will be used as one of the factors staff will consider when forming classes. Please do not request a specific teacher in your letter, rather provide specifics about classroom and learning environments that best support your child's needs. If your child is currently at our school and will not be attending Victoria West Elementary School next year, please advise the office staff if you have not already done so.

Parking at Vic West

There are certain areas that are unsafe and illegal to park in. In addition, <u>please do NOT park in the handicapped parking areas as these are needed by some of our community members</u>.

Late Arrivals/Early Departures - Need a Welcome Slip from the Office

Please ensure that your child comes to the office if they are late. They will be asked to sign in and take a welcome slip to class. Leaving prior to the bell, also requires a visit to the office so that your child can sign off and be on their way. This practice ensures that we know where your child is while in our care.
