Catchment Boundary Review Meetings

The District will be sharing their latest boundary review recommendations to the Board of Education this month after receiving community input on the phase three proposal.

The District hosted eight school-targeted consultation meetings in the month of May to discuss the proposed changes with the schools directly impacted while continuing to gather input online. The phase three proposal involved some new considerations for specific schools. As a result, the District felt it was important to directly connect with the school communities that could potentially be affected.

New recommendations are now planned to be presented to Trustees at a Special Board meeting on June 19th, 2019, where there will be an opportunity for attendees to submit input. The following week, the Board will meet again on June 25th, 2019 for final deliberations.

Watch for immunization consent packages for students in kindergarten to grade 4 who are behind on their immunizations. Students will be offered immunizations at a public health office with the consent of a parent, guardian or representative. Parent(s), guardians or representatives will be required to accompany students to the public health immunization appointment.

Students who are up to date on their immunizations will receive a record of immunization. Please keep this record to provide to your child's school this fall.

First Nations children who receive health services in their communities may be able to access immunization records and services at their Community Health Centers.

Parking at Vic West

There are certain areas that are unsafe and illegal to park in. In order for the morning and afternoon flow of traffic to remain safe to all persons on our school grounds, it is important for drivers to be aware of where it is ok to park and drop off/pick up. <u>Please do not park behind the school by the gym</u>. It is very difficult to be seen in that area, and there is a major safety concern for our students and staff. In addition, <u>please do NOT park in the handicapped parking areas as these are needed by some of our community members</u>.

Late Arrivals/Early Departures - Need a Welcome Slip from the Office

Please ensure that your child comes to the office if they are late. They will be asked to sign in and take a welcome slip to class. Leaving prior to the bell, also requires a visit to the office so that your child can sign off and be on their way. This practice ensures that we know where your child is while in our care.
