A HUGE thank you to our Vic West community for participating in our drill on Thursday afternoon! Our students listened well to their teachers and waited patiently to be picked up. Our staff worked very hard to practice our protocols and, as it was our first time, take notes on what we learned and could improve upon. Last and certainly not least, our parents were patient and understanding of the importance of the protocols despite some rather long lines.

The Reunification Drill started at approximately 1:08 pm. By 2:08 pm, we had released 85% of our students. Our district coordinator, Marketa Lund, said that it was the smoothest and fastest drill she had worked on (and she has worked with 60+ schools!). So... congratulations to Vic West on a very successful drill!

ChoirKids Reminder

Watch for immunization consent packages for students in kindergarten to grade 4 who are behind on their immunizations. Students will be offered immunizations at a public health office with the consent of a parent, guardian or representative. Parent(s), guardians or representatives will be required to accompany students to the public health immunization appointment.

Students who are up to date on their immunizations will receive a record of immunization. Please keep this record to provide to your child's school this fall.

First Nations children who receive health services in their communities may be able to access immunization records and services at their Community Health Centers.

Please contact the Esquimalt Health Unit at 250-519-5311 and ask to speak with a Public Health Nurse if you have any questions.

If your child is currently at our school and will not be attending Victoria West Elementary School next year, please advise the office staff if you have not already done so.


Games Club - Last One June 5, 2019

Parking at Vic West

There are certain areas that are unsafe and illegal to park in. In order for the morning and afternoon flow of traffic to remain safe to all persons on our school grounds, it is important for drivers to be aware of where it is ok to park and drop off/pick up. Please do not park behind the school by the gym. It is very difficult to be seen in that area, and there is a major safety concern for our students and staff. In addition, please do NOT park in the handicapped parking areas as these are needed by some of our community members.

Late Arrivals/Early Departures - Need a Welcome Slip from the Office

Please ensure that your child comes to the office if they are late. They will be asked to sign in and take a welcome slip to class. Leaving prior to the bell, also requires a visit to the office so that your child can sign off and be on their way. This practice ensures that we know where your child is while in our care.
