\*\*All visitors to the school <u>MUST</u> check in at the office. If you arrive to pick up your child during school hours, it is very important that you check in at the office to let staff know you are here. We also ask that if you are signing your child out, or signing your child in you do so starting at the office. We monitor very carefully all visitors to the building for many different reasons, but most of all for everyone's safety. We also have a system in place to keep track of our students and we track that through the classroom and through the office. #### **Parent Volunteers Needed in the Library**

We are looking for committed volunteers to help with putting books away in the library. If you are interested in helping out for one hour on a weekly basis, please stop in to talk with Mrs. Speller in the library to set up a time.

Volunteers are an important part of our school community. By generously donating their time

and expertise to our school, volunteers support the learning environment for our students.



Under the Greater Victoria School District's Regulation 1240 section 8 it states that: "The

principal will require a person interested in being a volunteer to obtain a criminal record check when working alone with a student, on overnight field trips or volunteering on an ongoing basis." If you will be volunteering at Vic West under any of these guidelines, a Criminal Record Check will be required.

Apply online for a Criminal Record Check at <u>https://justice.gov.bc.ca/eCRC/home.htm</u> Use our school's access code: **NPFWKLKFY8** 

Your Criminal Record Check will be sent directly to the school. The Criminal Record Checks will be valid for 5 years and will be forwarded to Middle Schools and/or new Elementary Schools as necessary.

Criminal Record Check applicants who do not have a credit history of at least six months or have not been living in Canada for at least two years will need to get a Volunteer Driver Letter from the school office to take it to your municipal police department.

We greatly appreciate all of our volunteer drivers taking the time to complete this process. This process is similar to ones in place in other Districts throughout the province. If you have any further questions please feel free to contact the school's Office.

\* The Criminal Record Review Program verifies identities through an Electronic Identity Verification (EIV) process. It is important to know that the Criminal Records Review Program is not running a credit report; it is only using the EIV to verify the applicant's identity and to make sure the personal information contained in the criminal record check form is accurate. No information from this process is retained or stored by the Criminal Record Check Program.

## **Library Time for Families**

Vic West Library opens at 8:30 for families. Students are welcome to come and read a book with a parent or caregiver before the first bell. Siblings are also welcome.

## Parking at Vic West

There are certain areas that are unsafe and illegal to park in. In order for the morning and afternoon flow of traffic to remain safe to all persons on our school grounds, it is important for drivers to be aware of where it is ok to park and drop off/pick up. <u>Please do not park</u> <u>behind the school by the gym</u>. It is very difficult to be seen in that area, and there is a major safety concern for our students and staff. In addition, <u>please do NOT park in the handicapped parking areas as</u> these are needed by some of our community members.



Just a reminder that the drop off zone at the front of the school is <u>not</u> a parking lot. Please drop off your child and continue to depart with your vehicle from the drop off zone to enable other families to do the same.

## Late Arrivals/Early Departures - Need a Welcome Slip from the Office

Leaving prior to the bell, also requires a visit to the office so that your child can sign off and be on their way. This practice ensures that we know where your child is while in our care.
