Late Arrivals/Early Departures –

Please do not park behind the school by the gym. This is a Pedestrian only Zone and is used for Non-Vehicle Traffic ONLY.



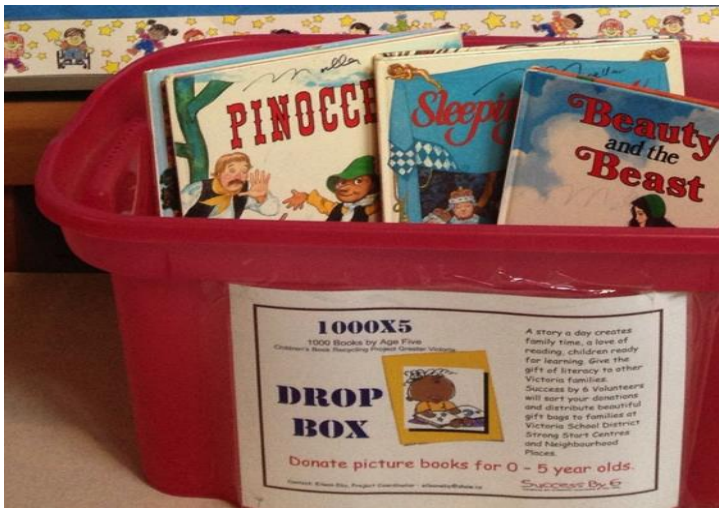
Parking with this symbol displayed is for those with accessibility needs ONLY. Your vehicle must display a similar symbol in order to use this space.
