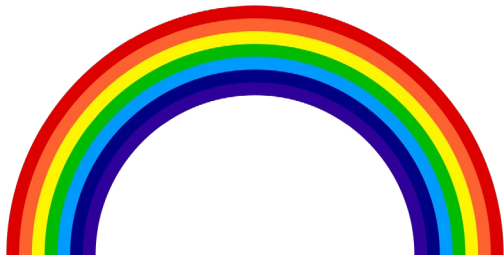

### Late Arrivals/Early Departures –

Please come to the main Office Door and call the office at 250-382-9131 to be admitted.

Families will need to call the office and a staff member will meet the student at the front door and walk them to their classroom. If you are picking up your child before the end of the day, please contact the office and we will arrange to meet you with your child at the front doors.



### Parking at Vic West

The drop off zone at the front of the school is not a parking lot. Please drop off your child and continue to depart slowly with your vehicle from the drop off zone on the same side of the street as the school building to enable other families to do the same.

Please do not park behind the school by the gym. This is a Pedestrian only Zone and is used for Non-Vehicle Traffic ONLY.
